II. Recognition

A. Cody Sinclair-WEBT Board Representative – Craig Dougherty
Superintendent Craig Dougherty recognized Human Resources Coordinator Cody Sinclair's work as a board member on the Wyoming Educators' Benefit Trust (WEBT). Mr. Dougherty explained that Mr. Sinclair was elected to the WEBT board in 2011 and will be serving his second three-year term as a board member of WEBT with his recent re-election. Superintendent Dougherty said that Mr. Sinclair is a true leader who has devoted numerous hours to quarterly board meetings and required training as a WEBT board member.

TRUSTEE O'DELL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

VI. Old Business

A. Capital Construction Update (*Information*) – Craig Dougherty

Superintendent Craig Dougherty reported that site work on Henry A. Coffeen is continuing. The move of Henry A. Coffeen to the new building and the move of Fort Mackenzie and the Wright Place to the old Highland Park site is complete. The Board will have a tour of the new Henry A. Coffeen on August 8th at 4:00 pm and staff will be allowed into the building on August 9th. Also, the cornerstone ceremony by the Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Wyoming is scheduled for Saturday, August 9, 2014 at 3:00 pm.

Superintendent Dougherty said that the Sheridan High School renovation is underway. This includes replacing doors in the commons area, remodeling the counseling office, completing the fire alarm and data networking system, and completing the administration offices remodel. Athletics and performing arts committees looking at the locker room/sports training and the performing arts areas continue to meet with Activities Director Don Julian.

The roof replacement project of the Early Building is in progress, with the back parking lot currently closed for safety.

Fort Mackenzie/the Wright Place has been moved to the old Highland Park building and will be added to the Wyoming State Facilities Commission list for construction of a new building. The District will work with the state to seek funding for a new facility.

B. Approval of Policies (*Action*) – Cody Sinclair

Human Resources Coordinator Cody Sinclair said that three policies were being presented for second reading and that there were no changes to those policies between first and second reading.

SECOND READING

TRUSTEE JIM PERKINS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT POLICY GCBA – PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARY SCHEDULE, POLICY JEA – COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGES, AND POLICY JEA-E – CONSENT TO WITHDRAW ON SECOND READING, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

C. Graduation Committee Update (*Information*) – Mitch Craft

Sheridan Junior High School Principal Mitch Craft shared the draft of the Graduation Counts Purpose Statement. He explained that many people collaborated on the draft to give the group direction. He said that they will work to establish early warning signs for potential drop-outs and focus on those areas. The Graduation Counts Committee has been working to engage the community, community groups, and legislators to provide various types of support.

Trustee Hininger added that district teachers are a dedicated group of professionals who are working to help students graduate.

VII. New Business

A. Approval of Budget Amendments for the Fiscal Year 2013-14 (*Action*) – Roxie Taft

Business Manager Roxie Taft said that one budget amendment would be needed to close fiscal year 2013-2014. The major maintenance budget increased from \$2,609,610 to \$2,626,610. This increase of \$17,000 is to account for the increase in interest revenue and offsetting expenditures

TRUSTEE ANN PERKINS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE INCREASE OF \$17,000 WITHIN THE FY14 MAJOR MAINTENANCE BUDGET, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE ANN PERKINS MADE A MOTION TO RECESS THE MEETING FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FY15 BUDGET AT 6:27 PM. TRUSTEE O'DELL SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

B. Approval of Budget for the Fiscal Year 2014-15 (*Action*) – Roxie Taft

Business Manager Roxie Taft offered the following fund amounts for the 2014-2015 fiscal year:

Ms. Taft said that the overall general fund budget will increase by 3.2% and includes a 52.273 increase in funded ADM. According to the plans set forth by principals and building staff, students in K-2 will have access to iPads and students in grades 3-5 and 6-8 will be provided with a Chromebook. All students in English classrooms for grades 9-12 will also be given access to Chromebooks. Ms. Taft added that in addition to the 25 mill levies required by law, an optional 1 mill levy for the Recreation District was included in the proposed budget, as it has been in past years.

TRUSTEE ANN PERKINS MADE A MOTION TO RETURN TO REGULAR SESSION AT 6:38 PM. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE O'DELL MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE FY15 BUDGET OF \$72,597,237 AND MILL LEVIES, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE HININGER SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

C. Approval of Wyoming High School Activities Association Activity Enrollment and Catastrophic /Liability Insurance (Action) – Terry Burgess

Assistant Superintendent Terry Burgess said that the total cost of activity fees and catastrophic/liability insurance for the 2014-2015 school year would be \$7,483 for 1,069 athletes in grade 6-12.

TRUSTEE SCHATZ MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE WYOMING HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION ACTIVITY ENROLLMENT AND CATASTROPHIC/LIABILITY INSURANCE, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE ANN PERKINS SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

D. Request Permission to Bid Milk FY15 (Action) – Roxie Taft

Business Manager Roxie Taft explained that milk purchases are currently made through a co-op delivery system. There have been issues with the current process, and she is requesting permission to bid milk services to see if better cost, schedules, and services are available.

TRUSTEE O'DELL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE REQUEST TO BID MILK FOR FY15, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

- E. Request Permission to Bid Bus Surveillance Equipment 2014 (*Action*) – Steve Schlichting
Transportation Director Steve Schlichting explained that each of the buses in the fleet need to have two external cameras per state statute. The new equipment must be in place by July 1, 2017, and the district has been allocated up to \$180,000 for these systems.

TRUSTEE ANN PERKINS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REQUEST TO BID BUS SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT FOR 2014, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION.

Trustee Jim Perkins asked if the buses that are bid for bus replacement in the future would only have certain cameras available. Mr. Schlichting responded that the District would be allowed to choose the cameras for the new buses.

Business Manager Roxie Taft added that the camera installation would need to be completed by June 30, 2015 in order to be reimbursed this year.

THE MOTION PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

- F. **Request Permission to Bid a 3-D Printer (*Action*) – Tom Sachse**
Assistant Superintendent Tom Sachse said that the District received a grant to facilitate the transition of Highland Park and Sheridan Junior High to become Science-Technology-Engineering-Mathematics (STEM) schools. In order to move forward with the transition, Dr. Sachse asked that a bid be advertised for a 3-D printer for Sheridan Junior High School.

TRUSTEE JIM PERKINS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REQUEST TO BID A 3-D PRINTER, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE HININGER SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT PASSED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

Student Planning Office Teacher Ed Fessler reported on the utilization and services of Student Planning Office, PSAT and SAT examinations, Advanced Placement examinations, ACT examinations, financial aid planning, offers of gift aid, and postsecondary education planning.

IX. District Administration Reports

A. Superintendent

Superintendent Craig Dougherty thanked Business Manager Roxie Taft and Assistant Business Manager Laurie Walsh for their hard work. He commented on Ms. Taft's exemplary interest in student learning.

Superintendent Dougherty said that the District is used as a resource time and again, as our students display some of the most outstanding learning in the state. He is participating in the Wyoming Leadership Collaborative in late July on the University of Wyoming campus. A Delaware-based firm has been hired by the Wyoming legislature, and they will interview Superintendent Dougherty in early August. The interview process will provide the legislature with information regarding the K-12 educational process in Wyoming.

Superintendent Dougherty added that the teachers have been busy with professional development this summer. Summer school will begin on July 21st, with a focus on small group and intensive study. Trustee Jim Perkins brought the idea of having summer school closer to the start of the school year.

Henry A. Coffeen Elementary School

Construction is nearly complete at Henry A. Coffeen. Furniture is in place and teachers have been in the building to start setting up classrooms. Board members will be given a tour of the building at 4:00 pm on August 8th. The cornerstone ceremony by the Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Wyoming, marking the completion of the project, is scheduled for Saturday, August 9, 2014 at 3:00 pm. An open house will be scheduled in early fall.

Sheridan High School Projects and Future Planning

Phase II of the Sheridan High School renovation is continuing. The furniture is being placed into the counseling offices and the wiring is being trimmed. The commons and mezzanine doors, ceiling, and light installation will continue over the next several weeks. The fire alarms are 65% complete and will continue to be installed until the start of school.

Athletics and performing arts committees looking at the locker room/sports training and the performing arts areas continue to meet with Activities Director Don Julian. These committees continue to seek private funds along with using the available District and state major maintenance funds.

Tyson Emborg will be present to discuss the continued efforts on fundraising for the remodel of the locker rooms and performing arts areas as well as a concept for the Larry Hurst Pathway from Sheridan College to Woodland Park.

Early Building Roof Replacement

The roof replacement project is progressing smoothly. We expect the majority of this project to be complete by the start of school.

Fort Mackenzie/the Wright Place and Sagebrush

Fort Mackenzie and the Wright Place have been moved to the old Highland Park Elementary School. The District will work with the School Facility Commission to secure funding for the construction of a new facility for Fort Mackenzie and the Wright Place and the complete renovation of Sagebrush Elementary School.

During the July 16th board meeting you approved the request for permission to bid milk for FY15. The bids were opened on July 5th as follows:

Bid Recap:

- We received bids from two vendors: Food Services of America and Meadowgold Dairy.
- The price per carton of 1% milk was .29 from Meadowgold versus .234 from Food Services.
- The price per carton of skim chocolate milk was .31 from Meadowgold versus .228 from Food Services.

I recommend that the bid be awarded to Food Services of America as the low bidder. I will request that you take action to approve the recommendation at your August 11th board meeting.

SUBJ: **Approval of Routes and Non-Public Road Travel** (*Action*)

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) requires that all routes be approved by local school boards on a yearly basis. The main concern for the WDE is that the routes comply with the state-mandated walking distances and for travel on roads other than those maintained by city, county, state, and federal governments.

When the routes are planned or revised, the following state mandated walking distances are considered:

- Elementary school walking distance equals 1.0 mile radius or less around school
- Junior High school walking distance equals 1.5 mile radius or less around school
- High school walking distance equals 2.0 mile radius or less around school

There are circumstances that are considered when the routes are planned that may include impediments such as physical barriers (rivers, busy streets, dead end streets, etc.), sexual predator homes, and situations that may compromise student safety. In these cases, the walking distance rule does not apply. Also, we pick up students within the walking distance radius, as defined above, if the path of the bus going to or from school goes right past a bus stop located within the walking distance. Bus routes are in a constant state of flux due to changes in population distribution. Copies of bus routes are available upon request and are published in the Sheridan Press within the "Back to School Issue."

Our routes are planned to best serve our student population in as safe a manner as possible. To accomplish this task, there are times when our buses must travel on non-public roads. The attached table contains a list of all the roads that are currently traveled by our route buses, public and private.

I will request that you take action to approve the bus routes and non-public road travel at your board meeting on August 11th.

SUBJ: **2015 - 2016 Bus Replacement Authorization (Action)**

Background

In 2002, the Wyoming Department of Education established the *State Bid/District Buy Program* for the purchase of new school buses. The state requests bids, based on the need for new buses in each district across the state, from various bus dealers. The state then provides each district with prices for the requested bus types from each vendor, along with a median cost. Each district usually chooses buses from this list, which are below or equal to the median price figure the state has provided. If the district wishes to add non-state supported options to the baseline specification or exceed the median price provided by the state, the district must do so at their own expense. Selection of bus vendors is the next step in the acquisition process, at which time each district will arrange payment method. I am recommending that we utilize this process to replace the buses listed below in fiscal year 2015 - 2016.

The buses will meet the criteria for replacement under the WDE *State Bid/District Buy Program*. Bus 20 will qualify with an optimal odometer reading of 175,000 miles or greater by July 2015. Bus 27 will qualify with an optimal life cycle of 12 years when it is replaced in 2015. Bus 51 will qualify with an optimal life cycle of greater than 8 years when it is replaced in 2015. It was inherited from the Even Start program and does not meet our needs for capacity. At the present time, the Wyoming Department of Education reimburses our district 100% of bus replacement costs. I will ask that you take action to approve the authorization to replace the buses listed above.

SUBJ: **Summer School Update** (*Information*)

Elementary

Each of our five elementary schools personalized their own summer school by using their site teachers to work with their specific students July 21st – August 8th, except Woodland Park which will conclude on August 15th.

The focus continues to be remediation in small groups for those students in kindergarten through fourth in all core areas. Summer school teachers received three days of professional development from Sherry Thompson (Math Coordinator) in Developing Number Knowledge (DNK) to assist in this process. I will provide more specifics on the 11th.

Junior High

Sheridan Junior High School summer school, now called Running Start, began Monday, August 4, and will finish on Friday, August 15. Running Start is serving 58 students entering grades 6-8. Each student takes a combination of courses in Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, and PE. Running Start teachers have worked to design interdisciplinary lessons based on a variety of skills essential for success in SJHS courses. Students attending Running Start are honing these essential skills just before the school year begins, providing each with a strong start as we move into the 2014-15 academic year.

High School

This summer we offered three sessions for students to earn credit at Sheridan High School.

The first session began on June 5th and ended on June 25th. This three-week session of classes had 47 students enrolled in Algebra 1B, Writing Revolution, Core of Discovery, and Environmental Science.

The second summer school offering took place in and around Sheridan as well as at the Wyoming High Country Lodge in the Big Horn Mountains. This cross curricular course took place during the last week in June. While exploring sites around the area like the Medicine Wheel, Acme, and Tie Flume, 21 students earned elective credit in science, history, or math.

The last summer school offering is taking place now, from August 4th to August 15th. This session currently has 32 students, 28 of which are incoming freshmen, enrolled in math, history/English, and two students recovering credit on Compass Learning.
