II. Approval of Agenda

TRUSTEE SCHATZ MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE PERKINS SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

III. Recognition

A. Summer Science GATE Program – Pat Brackley

Tom Sachse, Assistant Superintendent introduced Pat Brackley, former SCSD#2 Gifted and Talented Instructor. Ms. Brackley reported on the Summer Science Institute that was held June 5-7 for students in the GATE Program. This year the students dissected, identified, and compared sheep brains, cow eyes and hearts, and fetal pigs. She reported that this was a collaborative effort between School Districts #1 and #2, and Sheridan College that was attended by twenty-four fifth and sixth grade students. Ms. Brackley thanked the Board and District administration for supporting enrichment opportunities for high ability elementary students.

VI. Old Business

A. Capital Construction Update (*Information*) – Craig Dougherty:

Craig Dougherty, Superintendent, reported that construction at Meadowlark Elementary is complete. Teachers' belongings are being moved to the new building. The Open House and ribbon cutting for the public will be planned for a date after school begins.

B. Approval of Policies (*Action*) – Cody Sinclair

Cody Sinclair, Human Resources Coordinator, stated that seven policies were up for second reading this month. Mr. Sinclair reported changes have not been made to the policies since first reading.

C. Request to Award Bids for Copy Paper for 2012-2013 (*Action*) – Roxie Taft

Roxie Taft, Business Manager, reported that the District received two bids for copy paper. Ms. Taft recommended awarding the bid to the lowest bidder, Contract Paper Group.

TRUSTEE HACKMAN MADE A MOTION TO AWARD THE 2012-2013 COPY PAPER BID TO CONTRACT PAPER GROUP, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE CRAFT SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

- D. Approval of Name Adjustment for Coffeen Elementary (*Action*) – Scott Stults**
Scott Stults, Director of Elementary Education, said Coffeen Principal Nikki Trahan shared a recommendation to adjust the name of Coffeen Elementary School to *Henry A. Coffeen Elementary* or *Henry Asa Coffeen Elementary* at the June Board Meeting. He asked the Board to take action on choosing that name adjustment at tonight's meeting. Mr. Stults introduced Judy Slack, the librarian of the Wyoming Room at the Fulmer Public Library, who provided a PowerPoint presentation on the life and times of Henry A. Coffeen. Mike Mackey, a local author, also spoke about Henry Coffeen's focus on education during his lifetime. The presenters noted that Coffeen referred to himself as Henry A. Coffeen in his signature.

TRUSTEE BRIDGER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE NAME ADJUSTMENT OF COFFEEN ELEMENTARY TO HENRY A. COFFEEN ELEMENTARY, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

- E. Summer School Update (*Information*) – Scott Stults**
Scott Stults, Director of Elementary Education, presented an overview of student numbers and the subjects covered during summer school this year. He reported that one hundred forty-five kindergarten through fifth grade students attended summer school, and received instruction in reading, writing, and mathematics. In addition, students could attend one hour of enrichment activities each day. Fifty-one sixth through eighth grade students were provided intervention in math, language arts, and history. Forty-one high school students were enrolled in various classes.

VII. New Business

- A. Sheridan High School Planning Office Report (*Information*) – Dirlene Wheeler**
Dirlene Wheeler, Sheridan High School Principal, introduced Ed Fessler of the Sheridan High School Student Planning Office. Mr. Fessler presented an overview of the *Student Planning Office June Report 2012*. He reported on the number of students taking the PSAT, SAT, ACT, and Advanced Placement examinations and their scores, and postsecondary education plans for the class of 2012. Mr. Fessler reported that one hundred forty-four graduates, 74.2% of the senior class, received scholarships and awards in the total amount of \$4,543,391.
- B. Request to Award Bids for Sagebrush Elementary Playground Equipment (*Action*) – Julie Carroll**
In Julie Carroll's absence, Business Manager Roxie Taft presented the bids received for the replacement of playground equipment destroyed by vandalism at Sagebrush Elementary. The request for bids stated that the successful bidder must be able to complete installation of the playground equipment by August 24th. Ms. Taft reported that

six bids were received. She recommended awarding the bid to the lowest bidder, Playstructures & Recreation for \$41,601.00.

TRUSTEE PERKINS MOVED TO APPROVE THE ADVERTISING OF THE BID FOR REPLACEMENT OF SAGEBRUSH PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND AWARD THAT BID TO PLAYSTRUCTURES & RECREATION, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE DRUMMOND SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

C. Approval of Consolidated Grant Application (Action) – Tom Sachse

Tom Sachse, Assistant Superintendent, reported that the District's Consolidated Grant application was submitted for approval in advance of the July 1st due date. He said that the District is applying for \$2,585,646 dollars including 22.66 positions. Dr. Sachse pointed out that this year has a special challenge, as the federal agencies have been put on notice that unless Congress acts by January 2, 2013; all federal expenditures will be reduced by 9%. Contingency plans have been made if the 9% sequestration takes place.

TRUSTEE DRUMMOND MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CONSOLIDATED GRANT APPLICATION, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

D. Board of Trustees SEEDA Representative (Action) – Tom Sachse

Tom Sachse, Assistant Superintendent, recommended that the Board extend Trustee Steel's appointment to the SEEDA Board for another three-year term.

TRUSTEE DRUMMOND MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE APPOINTMENT OF MOLLY STEEL AS THE SEEDA REPRESENTATIVE FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE O'DELL SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE SCHATZ MADE A MOTION TO RECESS TO A PUBLIC HEARING AT 7:00 P.M. TRUSTEE HACKMAN SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

E. Approval of Budget Amendments for the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 (Action) – Roxie Taft

Roxie Taft, Business Manager reported that she has three proposed budget amendments for the Board's approval. The first amendment is to move \$157,000 from the General Fund to the Early Retirement Fund for the FY12 retirement obligations. The second amendment is to reclassify the early retirement fund as a debt service fund; this amendment is in response to an accounting change made by the Wyoming Department of Education. The third amendment is to transfer funds into the 2000 program code (Instructional Support).

F. Approval of Budget for the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 (Action) – Roxie Taft

Business Manager Roxie Taft presented a slideshow to report details of the proposed 2012-2013 budget. She covered several areas including historical information, the importance of Average Daily Membership (ADM), the revenue and expenditure budgets

for all funds, and expenditures per student. Ms. Taft reported that the proposed FY13 Budget is a 3% increase from last year.

Chairman Hininger asked if there were any public comments on either the FY12 Budget amendments or the FY13 Budget. No audience members chose to comments.

TRUSTEE CRAFT MADE A MOTION TO RETURN TO REGULAR SESSION AT 7:13 PM. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE PERKINS MADE A MOTION WITHIN THE FY12 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO INCREASE THE 6000 PROGRAM CODE AND DECREASE THE 1000 PROGRAM CODE BY \$157,000 TO FUND THE EARLY RETIREMENT OBLIGATIONS APPROVED BY THE BOARD. THESE FUNDS SHALL BE CONSIDERED COMMITTED PER OUR GASB 54 POLICY, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE DRUMMOND SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE HACKMAN MADE A MOTION TO RECLASSIFY THE EARLY RETIREMENT FUND AS A DEBT SERVICE FUND FOR FY12 DUE TO A CHANGE IN FUND CLASSIFICATIONS BY THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND TO INCREASE THE GENERAL FUND TRANSFER INTO THE EARLY RETIREMENT FUND BY \$157,000 TO FUND THE FY12 EARLY RETIREMENT OBLIGATIONS, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE SCHATZ SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE DRUMMOND MADE A MOTION WITHIN THE FY12 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO INCREASE THE 2000 PROGRAM CODE BUDGET BY \$50,000, DECREASE THE 1000 PROGRAM CODE BUDGET BY \$50,000, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE O'DELL SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

TRUSTEE SCHATZ MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013, AS PRESENTED. TRUSTEE HACKMAN SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED WITH A UNANIMOUS VOTE.

Background

Per the *State Bid/District Buy Program* for the purchase of new school buses, I am recommending that we replace the buses listed below in fiscal year 2013.

The buses will meet the criteria for replacement under the WDE *State Bid/District Buy Program*. Bus 2 and 4 will qualify with an optimal life cycle of 12 years when they are replaced in 2013. Bus 27 will qualify with an optimal life cycle of 8 years when it is replaced in 2013. The 2004 Yukon will qualify with an optimal life cycle of 9 years and Bus 49 will qualify with an optimal mileage of 200,000 miles or greater when it is replaced in 2013. At the present time, the Wyoming Department of Education reimburses our district 100% of bus replacement costs. Please approve the authorization to replace the buses listed above.

SUBJ: **Approval of Routes and Non-Public Road Travel (Action)**

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) requires that all routes be approved by local school boards on a yearly basis. The main concern for the WDE is that the routes comply with the state mandated walking distances and for travel on roads other than those maintained by city, county, state, and federal governments.

One copy of all the routes will be included for the Board and another copy will be available at the desk of Angie Winn (Superintendent Secretary). The package is large enough that making multiple paper copies or e-mailing it, would be too impractical.

When the routes are planned or revised, the following state mandated walking distances are considered:

Elementary school walking distance equals 1.0 mile radius or less around school
Junior High school walking distance equals 1.5 mile radius or less around school
High school walking distance equals 2.0 mile radius or less around school

There are circumstances that are considered when the routes are planned and these will include things like physical barriers (rivers, busy streets, dead end streets, etc.), where sexual predators live, and for any other reason that student safety might be compromised. In these cases, the rule for the walking distance radius does not apply. We also pick up students within the walking distance radius, as defined above, if the path of the bus going to or from school goes right past a bus stop located within the walking distance. Bus routes are in a constant state of flux due to changes in where our student population reside. Copies of most bus routes are available upon request and are published in the Sheridan Press "Back to School Issue".

Our routes are planned to best serve our student population in as safe a manner as possible. To accomplish this task, there are times when our buses must travel on non-public roads and the following table contains a list of all the roads that are currently traveled by our route buses--public and private.

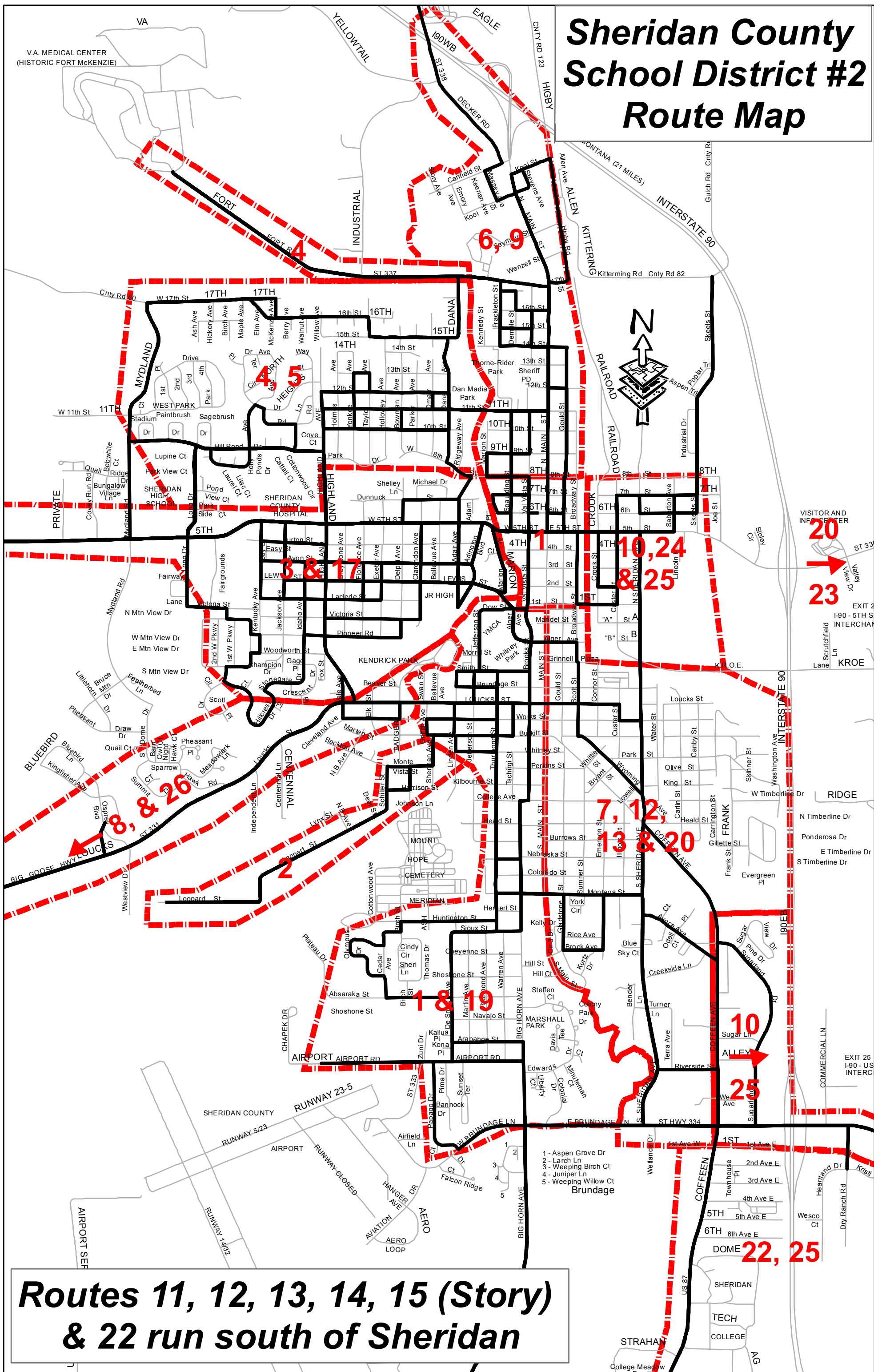
We look forward to providing safe transportation to and from school, as well as for all other school trips. The upcoming school year brings with it many changes that affect how our bus routes are now configured. These changes include the boundary changes for both Meadowlark and Coffeen Schools, the opening of the new Meadowlark School on DeSmet Avenue and moving Coffeen School to Avon Street to accommodate the reconstruction of that school on Sheridan Avenue. Almost every bus route has been revised, so please verify your bus stop and time, using the bus routes included in this issue.

When you and your child register at school, there will be a “Bus Agreement and Rules” form included in your registration packet. At the bottom of this form are two parts that need to be returned to school staff members. The bottom part will go back to the school office and the upper part needs to be sent with your child to give to their bus driver. During the first week of school, your child’s bus driver will distribute Bus Handbooks. These handbooks contain all the rules and safety guidelines for riding the school bus in our district. Please take a few minutes to review this handbook with your child. The bus handbook and the revised elementary school attendance area map are also included on the school website; Go to <http://www.scsd2.com>, click on the “District” tab, then choose “Transportation.”

The safety of the children we transport is the number one priority at the Sheridan County School District 2 Transportation Department. We want everyone including parents, children, and other motorists to be aware of proper school bus safety protocols to keep the students in our community safe.

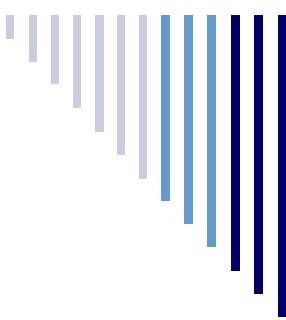

We achieved the Annual Yearly Progress (AYP) targets for all but a few small groups of students. At your meeting, I will highlight various aspects of our results for the 2012 school year. As in the past, at your September meeting elementary principals will present their school improvement plans and at your October meeting secondary principals will do the same.

2012 PAWS Assessment Results: An Introduction

The results that follow are best interpreted in context, by understanding the purpose and uses of these results as well as several important definitions. This brief introduction summarizes some of those background factors.

There are two major types of assessment information we rely on as a district and state to report students' achievement. These include the norm-referenced national test called Measures of Academic Programs (MAP) and the state's Proficiency Assessments of Wyoming Standards (PAWS). MAP gives results comparing students, schools, and districts to a national comparison group and to growth targets. PAWS gives results comparing students, schools, and districts to a state average of the percent of those scoring proficient or better, where proficiency is defined in terms of mastery of state standards.

The data portrayed below summarize the PAWS results for the 2012 academic year. For comparison purposes, this report uses the all students results. These are different than the results to determine AYP status. The PAWS results are represented as "percent proficient and above," so 55% percent means that 55% are proficient and advanced, the top two score bands and that 45% are basic and below basic, the bottom two score bands. Two types of group comparisons are shown: cross-sectional and longitudinal. Cross sectional graphs compare different groups of students, as in the third graders of 2010, the third graders of 2011, and the third graders of 2012. Longitudinal graphs compare the same group of students as they move through the grades. These are our preferred comparisons, since they are essentially the same group of students. It is important for the reader to recognize the cut-score defining proficiency varies from grade to grade. We also compare our schools with like schools in larger, more economically diverse settings in the state.

We color code these graphs to illustrate gains or losses by academic year. The color scheme we use is as follows: Wyoming Gold shows that scores remained the same from the previous year, yellow indicates a change in scores of either plus or minus two points in a year, green represents a positive growth of three to six points in a year, blue highlights a positive growth of seven or more points in a year, and red indicates a decline of three or more points from the previous year. Due to the "ceiling effect" we have not used negative color codes for those scores above 90%.

Any single indicator of achievement is fallible, so we try to discern patterns of scores over tests and grades. Is there generally a positive trend over all grades, district-wide? How are the math scores overall? How is a grade level span like intermediate grades 3, 4, & 5 doing? How is a school site performing? Such analyses are advisable before questions posed by test, teacher, or curriculum are possible. While the WDE discounts the 2010 results, we still report them as an accurate gauge of student achievement. Ultimately, no single score should have too much importance placed on it.
