

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

Executive sessions are not open to the public and may be convened for discussion on matters authorized by Wyoming law.

Unless a different procedure or vote is otherwise specified by law, an executive session may be held only pursuant to a motion that is duly seconded and carried by a majority vote of the Board.

The only persons who may attend executive sessions are board members, the superintendent and/or assistant superintendent (except when considering and preparing their evaluation or considering their salary) and other individuals the Board may invite to be present.

Minutes shall be maintained of any executive session. Executive session minutes shall be kept confidential and shall only be produced in response to a valid court order.

Board members and other persons attending an executive session shall not disclose matters discussed or considered during the executive session.
