SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT AUTHORITY

The employment of the Superintendent shall be the responsibility of the Board.

The Board delegates its executive powers to the Superintendent to the extent necessary for the Superintendent to manage the school system according to the provisions of law and the Board's policies, directives, and decisions. The Board reserves to itself the ultimate decision on all matters concerning policy, personnel and employment decisions, all expenditures of funds, and all other powers and duties that are by law given solely to the Board.

When administrative action must be taken within the school district in the absence of policy guidance or when an exception to policy may be appropriate, the Superintendent shall have the power to take such action as may be necessary. The Superintendent shall inform the Board of such action as soon as possible, but no later than the next regular Board meeting.
