

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Hazardous materials for the purpose of this policy include any substance or mixture of substances that pose a fire, explosive, reactive, or health hazard as more fully defined by law. The Board, through the superintendent, shall implement a program to address matters relating to the purchase, storage, handling, transportation, and disposal of hazardous materials. Appropriate school personnel are trained to take precautions to prevent accidents involving hazardous materials.

It is not the intent of the Board to expand or modify the district's potential liability exposure through the adoption of this policy. The district's voluntary compliance with any statute or regulation to which it is not otherwise subject will not be construed to create or assume any potential liability under any local, state, or federal law or regulation.
