CHILD FIND

Sheridan County School District No. 2 shall implement an ongoing system to locate, identify and evaluate all children residing within the School District who have disabilities and need early intervention under Part C or special education under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

The School District shall identify all children with disabilities regardless of the severity of their disability, including children with disabilities who are:

- 1. Highly mobile, such as migrant and homeless children;
- 2. Wards of the State;
- 3. Suspected of having a disability even though they advance from grade to grade;
- 4. Home schooled;
- 5. Attending a private (religious or secular) school located within the boundaries of the school district or public agency;
- 6. Attending a charter or virtual school;
- 7. Below the age of compulsory school attendance;
- 8. Above the age of compulsory school attendance who have not graduated from high school with a regular diploma and have not completed the school year in which they reach their twenty-first birthday; or
- 9. Dropped out or disenrolled from public or private school.
