

**HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION**

Sheridan County School District No. 2 shall offer homebound instruction to a student who is hospitalized or homebound for more than one (1) week because of an injury or illness that requires hospitalization or confinement at home. The student and/or parent/guardian must submit to the school district documentation and/or information from the student's licensed medical provider with regard to the injury or illness.

The building principal will recommend a homebound instructor from available staff, tutor list or substitutes.

The homebound instructor/teacher will utilize the district's curriculum and/or software to instruct the homebound student. The homebound instructor will consult with the homebound student's regular classroom teacher(s). The homebound instructor will be responsible for securing needed instructional materials from the school; coordinate instruction with course requirements in cooperation with the regular teachers; and submit a periodic evaluation of the student's performance to the regular classroom teacher(s).
