

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

The District shall offer homebound instruction to a student who is hospitalized or homebound for more than one (1) week because of an injury or illness that requires hospitalization or confinement at home. The student and/or parent/guardian must submit to the District documentation from a medical provider with regard to the injury or illness.

The building principal will recommend a homebound individual learning plan for the student.

The homebound individual learning plan will include course/curriculum and any online instruction plans. If a homebound instructor is needed, this will be included in the individual learning plan and the instructor will consult with the applicable classroom teacher(s). The homebound instructor will be responsible for securing needed instructional materials from the school; coordinate instruction with course requirements in cooperation with the teachers; and submit attendance and instruction requirements as stated in the homebound individual learning plan.
