EXEMPTIONS FROM REQUIRED INSTRUCTION

If the philosophical belief system of a student or his/her parents/guardian is contrary to the content of a school subject, or to any part of a school activity, the student may be exempt from participation. To receive such an exemption the parent / guardian must present a completed "Request for Exemption" (IMBB-E) to the school principal, stating the conflict involved.

If a student is unable to participate in a physical education class, he or she may present a statement to the principal from a medical professional stating the reason for the student's inability to participate.

Exemptions from required instruction will not excuse a student from the total semester credit hour requirement for graduation and/or promotion to the next grade.
