ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

DEFINITIONS

"Out of State Student" shall refer to any student who does not have a permanent residence in the state of Wyoming. Generally, residency in the state will require the physical presence of the student with a parent or guardian in the state with the intent to remain in the state. Temporary residences or residence for the purpose of obtaining school privileges is not sufficient. Students who only live in the state of Wyoming on a temporary basis for the convenience of attending schools or for other reasons, without intent to permanently reside in the state, will not be considered residents of the state.

"Out of District Student" shall refer to any student who resides in the State of Wyoming but is not residing within Sheridan County School District No. 2 with intent to make his/her residence within the School District a permanent residence. Students who only live in the School District on a temporary basis for the convenience of attending schools or other reasons, without intent to permanently reside in the District, will not be considered residents of the district.

TUITION

The District shall require as a condition for admission of an Out of State Student, the payment of tuition either by the student, his/her parents, or by the school district wherein the student resides as is required by W.S. 21-4-505 (b). The amount of tuition shall be as is required by W.S. 21-4-505.

The student shall not be admitted until the District of residence or responsible person has committed in writing to payment of the tuition and enrollment of the student.

ADMISSION

The Superintendent or his/her designee has the sole discretion to admit or not admit Out of State Students or Out of District Students to this School District for any reason deemed appropriate by the Superintendent except for students seeking admission pursuant to W.S. 21-4-501 (students residing in a district that does not maintain a high school).

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall review Out of State and Out of District students for admission on an annual basis and will determine on such review if admission is granted for the upcoming school year.

SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED STUDENTS

The District may deny admission to any student who has been suspended or expelled from another School District whether located in or outside the state, for the duration of the

suspension or expulsion regardless of whether or not the student establishes residency within this District.

TRANSPORTATION

The School District will not provide transportation for Out of State or Out of District Students except on regular bus routes running within the boundaries of this school district unless expressly consented to by the Board of Trustees.

LEGAL GUARDIAN

Every non-resident student attending the School District shall be required to have his/her legal guardian agree to be responsible for the student with regard to all educational decisions and who can authorize emergency medical treatment.

This policy does not apply to homeless students otherwise provided for in policy JD.
