

EXTRA-CURRICULAR AND INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES AND ATHLETICS

Extra-Curricular and Co-Curricular Activities (such as school play, intramurals and other activities within the district)

The school district will provide students with opportunities to participate in extracurricular and co-curricular activities designed for the age, interest, and ability level of students in its respective schools. All extra-curricular and co-curricular activities shall operate under the general supervision of the building principal and/or school activities director.

Extra-curricular and co-curricular activities shall adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Activity offerings shall be of sufficient variety and number to meet the wide range of interests of students. Participation shall be voluntary.
2. All clubs/organizations must be approved by the Superintendent or his/her designee and shall be supervised by a school district employee who is assigned as an Advisor for promotion or student participation.

It is a privilege and not a right to participate in extracurricular and co-curricular activities. Participation in such activities may be limited or conditioned upon compliance with school district policies, rules and regulations, codes of conduct, attendance, and maintaining satisfactory grades

Interscholastic Activities (such as WHSAA activities and other activities that compete outside of the district)

The school district shall also provide students in Sheridan High School and Sheridan Junior High School with opportunities to participate in interscholastic activities as approved by the Board. All interscholastic programs shall operate under the general supervision of the building principal and/or school activities director. Personnel who meet Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB) requirements will be assigned to coach and supervise the various interscholastic programs as needed.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR AND INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

The school district shall maintain membership in and adhere to the requirements of the Wyoming High School Activities Association ("WHSAA"). The Superintendent or his/her designee shall serve as the school district's voting representative at all meetings of the WHSAA. The eligibility of students to participate in WHSAA athletic programs will be determined in accordance with WHSAA regulations. The ability of students to participate in WHSAA catastrophic insurance, if available, will be determined in accordance with WHSAA regulations.

The school district and coaches of interscholastic programs may adopt rules and/or requirements pertaining to participation in such activities. In such an event, each student participant shall agree to abide by and comply with the requirements set forth by the school district and the responsible coaches as a condition of participation.

It is a privilege and not a right to participate in interscholastic activities. Participation in such activities may be limited or conditioned upon compliance with school district policies, rules and regulations, codes of conduct, attendance, and maintaining satisfactory grades.

In all extra-curricular and interscholastic activities, the District will follow all relevant federal and state statutes including Title IX and W.S. 21-25-101 et. seq.
