

HEAD LICE INFESTATION

Head lice represents a common childhood nuisance condition. The school nurse will inspect students with signs and symptoms of head lice infestation. The school will notify the parent or guardian of students found to be infested with live head lice. The parent or guardian of students infested with head lice will receive verbal and/or written instructions for the appropriate treatment to eliminate the lice, if necessary. If, in the judgment of the school building administrator, there is a reasonable risk of the student transmitting the head lice to others, the building administrator may exclude the student from school for up to ten (10) days.
