VEHICLE USE

Parking on school property is a privilege. The school district requires students and others to operate vehicles in a safe and reasonable manner at all times. Students or other individuals driving motorized vehicles to school must park in areas designated by the school administration. Vehicles are to be driven in a safe and prudent manner while on or immediately adjacent to the school grounds. State law and local ordinances are applicable to driving and or parking on school district property. Students are required to follow the school handbook regarding driving and/or parking on school district property.
