

**STUDENT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRING TRAVEL**

Students may receive an honor or award which requires traveling outside of a budgeted expense; either to receive the award or participate in a special activity. After receiving a written request, the principal or activities director may submit a recommendation to the Superintendent. The Superintendent may make recommendations to the Board concerning any student requests for assistance, taking into consideration the following:

1. Does the award or honor represent an unusual, significant, and worthwhile experience for the student and the school district?
2. Can the district help the student without detracting from the educational needs of other students?

On a case by case basis the Board may offer financial assistance for a student to participate in the requested activity.
