SCHOOL CONTACTS WITH NONCUSTODIAL PARENTS

The school district shall comply with all court orders and other law with respect to the rights of a noncustodial parent (parent who does not have the legal custody of his/her child) of a student enrolled in the school district. It shall be the responsibility of the parents to provide the school district with the copies of all orders affecting parental rights or the rights of the parent with respect to the student's education. Access to student records by non custodial parents shall be in accordance with court orders, if any, and Board policy JRA-P. The school district will maintain in the student's file all court orders affecting custody and a designation of the student's custodial and noncustodial parents.
