

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

All regular, special, and emergency meetings of the Board of Trustees, except during executive sessions, are open to the public.

The Board desires to hear the viewpoints of citizens throughout the district and may provide time during its regular meetings to receive comments from the public. The Board has established guidelines for public comment periods in Policy BEDH. The Board Chair is responsible for maintaining proper order during board meetings. The Board Chair may discontinue any presentation that violates the guidelines set forth in Policy BEDH and/or continue the public comment period at a different time as may be necessary. Questions asked by members of the public may, at the discretion of the Chair, be answered by a Board member or school district staff during the meeting or referred to the Superintendent for future consideration and/or response.
