ANNOUNCEMENTS IN THE SCHOOLS

The Superintendent or his/her designee may allow distribution of announcements and program material of non-profit community organizations that supplement a school program, such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, YMCA, Sheridan Recreation District, et al., when such cooperation will not interfere with the school district's purposes. In addition, and/or alternatively, the Superintendent or his/her designee may designate one or more areas in the District's buildings for such non-profit community organizations to display announcements and program materials (such as on a bulletin board or on a table).

The district may also utilize and post extra-curricular activity schedules and/or utilize programs with limited advertising contained thereon at the discretion of the Superintendent or his/her designee.

No other solicitation shall be permitted on school district property. Exceptions to this policy may be made at the discretion of the Superintendent or his/her designee when it is determined that the educational benefit and benefit to students outweighs potential exploitation by private interests. The Superintendent may at his/her option refer specific requests to the Board for a decision.
