ADVERTISING IN THE SCHOOLS

The superintendent or his/her designee may allow distribution of program material of non-profit community announcements and organizations that supplement the school program, such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, YMCA, Sheridan Recreation District, et al., when such cooperation will not interfere with the school In addition, and/or alternatively, the district purposes. superintendent or his/her designee may designate one or more buildings in their for such non-profit community organizations to display announcements and program materials (such as on a bulletin board or on a table).

The district may also utilize and post extra-curricular activity schedules and/or utilize programs with limited advertising contained thereon at the discretion of the superintendent or his/her designee.

No other advertisement or solicitation shall be permitted on school district property. Exceptions to this policy may be made at the discretion of the superintendent or his/her designee when it is determined that the educational benefit and benefit to students outweighs potential exploitation by private interests. The superintendent may at his/her option refer specific requests to the Board for a decision.
