## WHO WE ARE

The Parent Liaison Program was created in order to honor and support parents' involvement in school. The goal of the program is to develop a strong partnership between school and families that is critical for successful children. Parent liaisons are professionals who work as part of a school team. Parent liaisons:

- Bridge the gap between home and school.
- Have time to listen, encourage, and provide support to parents.
- Assist all parents in accessing school and community resources.
- Answer questions about parenting challenges.
- Provide parents the tools they need to enhance their child's development and ability to learn.

Parent liaisons are available to provide support to ALL families OUTSIDE of the classroom so that children are better able to thrive INSIDE the classroom.

## Programs provided by the Sheridan Parent Liaisons in SCSD#2 Elementary schools

*Parenting the Love and Logic Way* is provided free of charge at each elementary school throughout the school year. Free childcare will also be provided. The class meets one time weekly for a period of six weeks. Please check your individual school websites or Compass Center for Families or the Parent Liaison Facebook page for information and dates.

*Thriving Kinders* is a seminar for parents of Kinders that educates parents about the school's approach to learning and goals for kindergarten students. It works to create a culture that views parents and teachers as partners in a child's success. Not available at all schools.
