# Bus Agreement and Rules

School bus rules and regulations for the District, which are set forth in the Bus Handbook and Board policies, are summarized below. Paper copies of the Bus Handbook and applicable board policies can be obtained at the District Transportation Office located at 1514 E. Brundage Lane, by calling 672-3105, or by going online to <http://www.scsd2.com>. Please take time to read the Bus Handbook (both the pupil and parents). The rules and penalties for infractions, as outlined in the Bus Handbook, are in effect on the bus and at bus stops. School District buses may be equipped with video and/or audio recording devices to record the conduct and verbal communications of students riding on school buses. By entering into this Bus Agreement, parents and students consent to the recording of the student's conduct and verbal communications while on the bus and agree that the student does not have an expectation of privacy with respect to conduct and verbal communications on the bus. Complete the bottom portion of this form, cut on the dashed lines, then return each part to the appropriate school and driver.

### Rules and Regulations

1. Pupils are expected to be respectful, follow instructions and accept feedback from the driver or chaperone.
2. Guns, ammunition/explosives, knives and all other items that might be considered a weapon are prohibited.
3. Skateboards, scooters and skates will not be allowed, unless they are carried inside a bag and not taken out during the bus ride. Animals are not allowed on the bus.
4. Stay seated, face forward and keep aisle clear.
5. Keep all body parts inside the bus at all times.
6. Tobacco products, alcohol and drugs are prohibited on the bus and at bus stops.
7. Talk quietly - foul language and unruly behavior is not permitted.
8. Vandalism to the bus will be paid for by the pupil causing the damage. All trash will be placed in waste containers provided.
9. Bullying and harassment of other pupils will not be tolerated.
10. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
11. Food, drink and the use of portable electronic devices are not recommended, but will be at the driver's discretion.
