### Recommending Your Child for Seminar

Seminar is a program designed for 3rd-5th grade students whose intellectual capacity, academic achievement and rate of learning require experiences apart from the regular curriculum. These students are pulled out of their classrooms for ½ day a week to work on challenging activities designed to meet some of their social, emotional and intellectual needs. Children must score at the 95th percentile on cognitive-ability and achievement tests to participate in this program.
