



Outdoor Club is a space for students grades 6-8 to come together; make connections; share passions and explore curiosities about outdoor activities.


Activities may include local hiking trails, trail etiquette, hiking basics, leaving no trace, backpacking, bike riding and outdoor survival skills; and learn from local experts.





Hispanic Culture and Foods (M/W) – Students





