Enrollment

How do I enroll a student?

 Edmentum is a fully accredited K-12 online school partnering with SCSD#2 to offer highquality virtual courses with a relationships-first approach.

Can I take some courses virtually and others in-person?

• Yes, this is an option. There are limited spots available.

Pacing Requirement:

 If a student falls 70% or below according to the 'On Target' pacing grade, the student will be required to attend in-person guided intervention sessions if residing in Sheridan and Zoom if living outside of Sheridan.
