The following Sheridan County School District No. 2 schools have qualified for and will begin to provide school meals under Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for 2025 - 2026.

All Elementary Schools (PK-5)

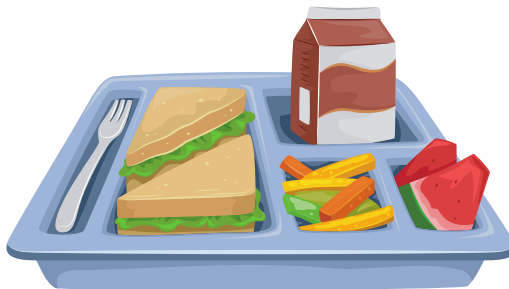

CEP is a federal program that allows qualifying schools to serve one free breakfast and one free lunch to all students at these schools. Schools qualify based on the percentage of students that qualify for free meals through direct certification by the State of Wyoming.

Meals at SCSD#2 schools are priced as a unit, and include 1 milk.

- Elementary (PK – 5), The Wright Place, John C. Schiffer
 - Breakfast and Lunch: \$0.00
- Sheridan Junior High School
 - Breakfast (6-8): \$1.75
 - Lunch (6-8): \$3.50
- Sheridan High School
 - Breakfast (9-12): \$2.00
 - Lunch (9-12): \$3.75
- Guest/Staff Meal: \$5.50
- Guest/Staff Salad Bar Only: \$3.50
- Extra milk: \$0.50



While SCSD2 is not guaranteed to qualify for this program permanently, we are excited to utilize CEP to bring zero cost meals to our students at these respective schools.

It is important that qualifying families submit 25-26 Free and Reduced Meal Applications, regardless of your school's CEP eligibility.
