SCSD2 ANNOUNCES NEW ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT

SHERIDAN, WYO -- At its monthly board meeting on March 9, the Sheridan County School District No. 2 Board of Trustees approved Justin Rohrer as the district's new Assistant Superintendent of Instruction and Personnel. Currently the principal at Sagebrush Elementary, Rohrer will start in his new position on July 1.

Rohrer's education career began as an elementary classroom teacher at Star Valley and Sagebrush Elementary. Currently finishing his fourth year as principal of Sagebrush Elementary, Rohrer's school has been recognized as Wyoming's top elementary school by Niche.com all four years of his tenure and was recognized as a National Blue Ribbon School.

Rohrer holds a Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from the University of Wyoming and a Masters degree in Educational Leadership from American College of Education.
