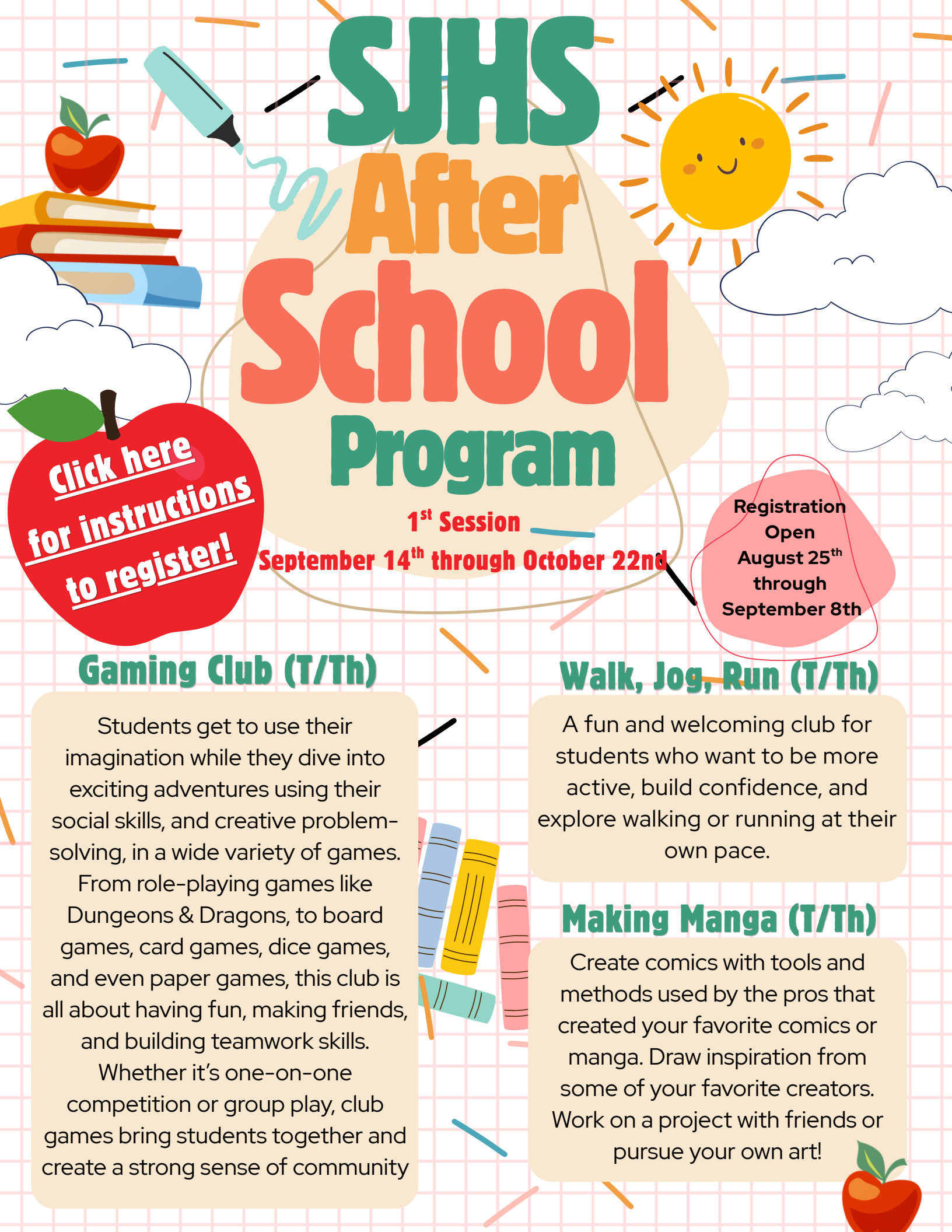

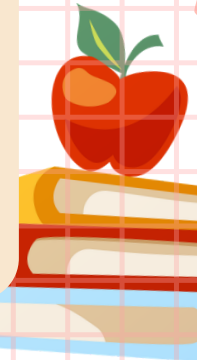

Outdoor Activities (M/W)

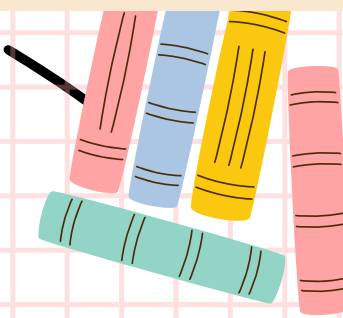
A fun and active club where students enjoy the outdoors through walks, park activities, frisbee, games, and time spent with friends in the fresh air.
