Monday/Wednesday Classes

Design/Create/Tinker & Cardboard Creations — Join us in the Einstein Lab and let your creative juices flow. You will have full access to the supplies and tools in the Einstein lab. Create your own cardboard pinball or similar game using as many recycled materials as possible and a little ingenuity.

Homework Club - Come enjoy a relaxing place to receive help with homework, missing assignments, or receive a little additional help to grasp a concept you've been struggling with. Other activities will include a comfy place to read, writing centers, or photography challenges.

Science/Engineering Challenges (M/W)-Do you like Engineering Challenges in science class? If so, you will enjoy this after school program where there will be a series of Engineering Challenges for you to solve. You will need to brainstorm designs, build & test prototypes, and then improve your models, until you have the best solution possible. Some Engineering Challenges include: Tallest Tower, Rube Goldberg Machine, Catapults, Boat Design, Balloon Cars, among others!

Tuesday/Thursday Classes

Bronc Study Club (M-Th) – This program provides a location for work completion in a structured, supervised setting. Once students have worked for the required time period, students then work on individual and group enrichment projects while using technology. There will be an ELA focus M/W and a math focus on T/Th, though work for all subjects can be completed during this class.

Tabletop Gaming Club (T/Th): Students use social skills and creative problem solving in role playing games. Tabletop games build teamwork skills and create a sense of community among members of campaigns or those involved in one-on-one competition.

World Building and Conlang (T/Th) – Invent the culture, language, history, and arts of a make-believe society—fantasy or realistic, historical or futuristic—combining elements of the creative arts, language arts, foreign language studies, and social studies in an epic work of team creativity.(Cap: 12 students).

Writing Club (T/Th) – Calling all authors! Do you want to develop your writing skills? Do you want to take more risks in your writing? Do you just need a creative outlet? Then SJHS Writing Club is for you! SJHS Writing Club will help young authors start and keep an idea journal while exploring writing that uses interesting combinations of narrative, informational, argumentative, and poetry. We'll use that exploration as an inspiration for writing.
